Master Composter Program



The UW-Extension Solid and Hazardous Waste Education Center, Dane County UW-Extension, Dane County Public Works Department, the City of Fitchburg and the City of Madison Public Works and Streets Division are partnering to offer a two-part Master Composter Certification Training on **March 5th and 12th from 6-9 pm at the Fitchburg Public Library.**

Certified Master Composters provide composting demonstrations and teach basic composting to members of their community.

This course is a train-the-trainer program designed for those who want to share their knowledge with others. It is **not** just to learn about home composting.



Along with the training, participants will take an open-book exam based on the Master Composter Home Study Course and pledge to teach (or co-teach) home composting sessions or set up composting demonstration displays and answer questions about composting at community events or in partnership with the Dane County UW-Extension office, SHWEC, Dane County Public Works or the City of Madison.

Cost:

There is a \$30 fee for the program, which includes a training manual, exam, refreshments and other supplies. Registrations after the February 27th postmark date will incur a \$10 late fee.
